<u>Copernicus Science Centre (CNK)</u>

An interactive science museum – learning through play.

<u>Vistula Boulevards</u>

A beautiful promenade along the river.

Vistula River Cruise

A boat trip with stunning city views.

<u>Multimedia Fountain Park</u>

Evening water, music, and light shows.

University of Warsaw Library (BUW)

A green rooftop garden – terrace with a city view.

<u>Old Town</u>

The historic heart of Warsaw, an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Royal Castle, Sigismund's Column, picturesque streets.

<u>City Zoological Garden</u>

A perfect spot for families with kids.

Attractions recommended by IBCS team

Fryderyk Chopin Museum

A museum with interactive exhibits, original Chopin manuscripts.

National Stadium (PGE Narodowy)

One of the largest stadiums in Poland. Stadium tours, events, and fairs.

Money Museum (NBP Money Centre)

An interactive museum about the history of money.

Wedel Chocolate Museum

The history of chocolate and its production process, chocolatemaking workshops, tastings.

Elektrownia Powiśle

Polish brands, beauty concepts, and luxury stores, food hall, wellness zone (manicure, hairdresser, cosmetics).

<u>Hala Koszyki</u>

A mix of design, fashion, and cosmetics combined with food, a great spot for lunch and shopping.

Public transportation

Metro – Two lines:

+ M1 (north-south, passing through Old Town and City Center)

+ M2 (east-west, connecting Stadium, City Center, and Wileński Station)

Buses & Trams – Extensive network operating from early morning until late at night.

- + "E" lines are express buses.
- + Night buses are marked with an "N".

SKM (Fast Urban Railway) – Trains connecting the city center with distant districts and Chopin Airport. Note: Green trains (Koleje Mazowieckie) require separate tickets.

Water Tram – A seasonal attraction available in summer.



Tickets for public transportation

Tickets are valid for all ZTM transport (metro, trams, buses, SKM except Koleje Mazowieckie). Please remember to validate your ticket immediately after boarding, otherwise, the ticket will be invalid. For electronic tickets, validation is done by scanning the QR code.

You can buy them at:

+ Ticket machines (at stations - cash or card and inside vehicles - card)

- + Kiosks and ZTM service points
- + Mobile apps (e.g., JakDojade, SkyCash, mPay)

Ticket types:

- + 20-minute ticket (3.40 PLN)
- + 75-minute ticket (4.40 PLN)
- + 24-hour ticket (15 PLN)
- + 3-day ticket (36 PLN)
